## I. Cumulative GEF-5 Approvals versus Programming Targets as of December 31, 2011

1. This bi-annual report summarizes the progress made in programming GEF-5 resources as of December 31, 2011. It provides a cumulative summary of GEF-5 utilizations against the programming targets that were established by the Council during the GEF-5 replenishment (*GEF 5 Programming Document GEF/R.5/31/CRP.1*). In addition, it details project approvals and endorsements as well as project cancellations during the six-month period from July 1 to December 31, 2011.

2. Total GEF grants and associated Agency fees approved by Council or the CEO amounted to \$1,005.02 million, representing 24% of programmed resources. The distribution of the approved amounts as compared to the corresponding programming targets is shown in Table 1 by focal areas, themes, programs and corporate budget.

## II. Approval of Grants and Agency Fees for the Period from July 1 to December 31, 2011

3. During the six-month period ended December 31, 2011, the GEF approved a total of \$531.85 million for financing projects, consisting of \$489.20 million in project grants, and \$42.66 million in associated fees to Agencies. Co-financing associated with total approval during this period was \$4,439.09 million (each GEF grant dollar was thus matched by approximately \$9.07 dollars in co-financing). Table 2 provides a summary illustration of the distribution according to project types.

5. Between July 1 and December 31, 2011, the CEO endorsed a total of 49 projects accounting for \$193.20 million in GEF grants and \$18.90 million in associated Agency fees, as detailed in Annex E.

### **IV. Project Cancellations for the Period from July 1 to December 31, 2011**

6. During the six-month ended December 31, 2011, the GEF has dropped three projects and two related PPGs of total value of \$6.92 million in GEF grants and \$0.69 million in associated Agency fees as detailed in Annex F.
